

Introduction to Outdoor Leader Skills/OWL

Camp Davy Crockett
September 11-14, 2015

This course is designed to provide Boy Scout and Webelos Leaders with an introduction to the basic outdoor skills used by the Boy Scouts of America. It is required training for Scoutmasters, Assistant Scoutmasters and Webelos leaders who wish to be fully trained in their position. It is also recommended for Troop Committee Members. Boy Scout Leaders should have completed Scoutmaster/Assistant Scoutmaster Leader Specific training and Webelos Leaders should have completed Webelos Leader Specific and Baloo training prior to taking the course. This course will satisfy the requirements for Outdoor Webelos Leader (OWL) training and will receive credit for OWL.

Registration and orientation will begin at 5:45 PM at the Headquarters Building at Camp Davy Crockett. Classes begin at 6:45 Friday evening and end around 1:30 on Sunday. It will be a full weekend of fun, learning and fellowship and you're sure to take home a pack full of scouting skills and undoubtedly a few memories as well.

This will be a camping weekend so come prepared for just about any type of weather. Leaders will become "scouts" for the weekend and will learn important outdoor skills and activities which should be a part of every unit's outdoor program. Food is provided in the course fee but you will need to bring the rest of your equipment. In the true spirit of scouting, the use of paper and plastic eating utensils and cups will be avoided; you will be responsible for bringing your own eating "equipment". *Dinner will not be served on Friday evening so be sure to eat before you come!*

YOU WILL NEED TO BRING THE FOLLOWING PERSONAL EQUIPMENT. If you do not have some of these items, now would be a good time to acquire them – particularly a compass – Yes, a compass . . . a standard Boy Scout type orienteering compass is recommended and is available from the scout shop as well as most outdoor stores.
